

# Stellantis Onboarding Supplier Checklist for ENLARGED EUROPE

**Note:** These activities should be completed within the next 30 days.

## eSupplierConnect Registration and Login

**eSupplierConnect provides collaboration and communication between Stellantis and supplier partners.** Go to [www.esupplierconnect.com](http://www.esupplierconnect.com) to register. Once logged into eSupplierConnect, be sure to register for the below applications as a start:

- **beStandard** (Direct Material Suppliers)
- **F4S** (Logistic portal for Material Schedule and plant communication)
- **SQP** (Logistic and Quality for direct Material and Supplier evaluation tool)
- **CAPMAN** (for the Supplier Production Capacity)
- **EMEA Purchase Order** (for the PO Inquiry)
- **Supplier Web Academy**
- **GST – Global Sourcing Tool** (Direct Material Suppliers)

## Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

All new Direct Material suppliers supporting Enlarged Europe production for the Stellantis ex-FCA plants, are required to choose between the two possibilities:

- Establish an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) in ODETTE format. For EDI implementation user guides, visit the F4S Portal that can be accessed through the eSupplierConnect Portal.
- Use the F4S portal to manually download the Material Schedule published in PDF format. F4S is a free tool (no cost is requested to the Suppliers).

**It is the supplier's responsibility to choose, between the two proposals, the one that best suits their needs.**

In case of EDI, **is responsibility of the Supplier to contact INTESA** (official EDI provider for Stellantis ex-FCA plants), using the information provide in the guide enclosed here.

While the EDI connection is not established, Suppliers are mandatory requested to use F4S portal to download the Material Schedule sent by the plant and have to provide the requested component respecting the date.
