


Purpose of Guide

In order to attend one of NWIRP's DACA Renewal Clinics, you must submit **PDF versions** of your previous DACA Application. In this guide, you will learn how to scan and upload your PDF documents using either an iPhone/iPad or a Smartphone/Tablet.


Step 1 - for an iPhone or iPad

Here, you will learn how to scan paper copies of your documents into **PDF format** on an **iPhone or iPad** using the "Notes" app. If the app is not already on your device, you will first need to download the app from the App Store. ***If are using a Smartphone or Tablet to scan your documents, skip to page 2 of this guide.***


Note: If your documents are already in PDF format, skip to page 4 of this guide.




1. To begin, tap the "Notes" icon.




2. Tap the "new note" icon in the bottom right corner.




3. Tap the "camera" icon.




4. Tap "Scan Documents."




5. Hold your device over the document until the yellow box appears around it. Then, tap the circle. Only tap "save" once ALL pages have been scanned.



6. Tap the circle icon in the upper right corner. Then, tap "Send a Copy."



7. Tap "Save to Files."



8. Tap "On My iPhone" (or "On My iPad" if using an iPad). Then, tap "Save" in the upper right corner to save the PDF to your device.

Step 1 for a Smartphone/ Tablet: How to Scan Documents to PDF Using OpenScan

Step 1 - for Smartphone or Tablet


Here, you will learn how to scan paper copies of your documents into **PDF format** on a **Smartphone or Tablet** using **OpenScan**. To do so, you will first need to download the free "OpenScan" app from your device's App Store.

If are using an iPhone or iPad to scan your documents, refer to page 1 of this guide.


Note: If your documents are already in PDF format, skip to page 4 of this guide.




1. The OpenScan App will appear on your home screen once downloaded. To open, tap the "OpenScan" icon.




2. Allow OpenScan access to photos, media, and files, as well as access to take pictures and record video.




3. Tap the "+" to begin scanning.




4. Tap "Normal Scan."




5. Line up the document in the frame and tap the circle.





6. Tap the “✓” if the scan is clear and readable. Tap the “🗑️” if you need to redo the scan.




7. Tap “Done” to save the scan. Repeat steps 3-7 until each page is scanned.



8. Once you’re done scanning, tap the PDF icon in the upper right corner to combine all pages into one document.



9. Tap the 3 vertical dots in the upper right corner. Then, tap “download”. This will save your PDF scans to “Files” on your device. If you would like to email the PDF scans to yourself to save them on a computer, tap “Send file...” and enter your email.



10. To find the scans, search for “Files” in your phone’s search bar. They will be in “downloads”.





1. Once on NWIRP's DACA Online Registration page, to upload the PDF scan, tap "Select a file from device." Then, tap "Browse."



2. In the "Recents" section, tap the PDF scan you wish to upload to the Online Registration Page. Repeat steps 1-2 for each required document.


